Imaging 3.0: Patient centric radiology. Improve patient outcomes, more cost effective care, increase radiologist relevance in healthcare, based reporting with evidence-based follow-up recommendations



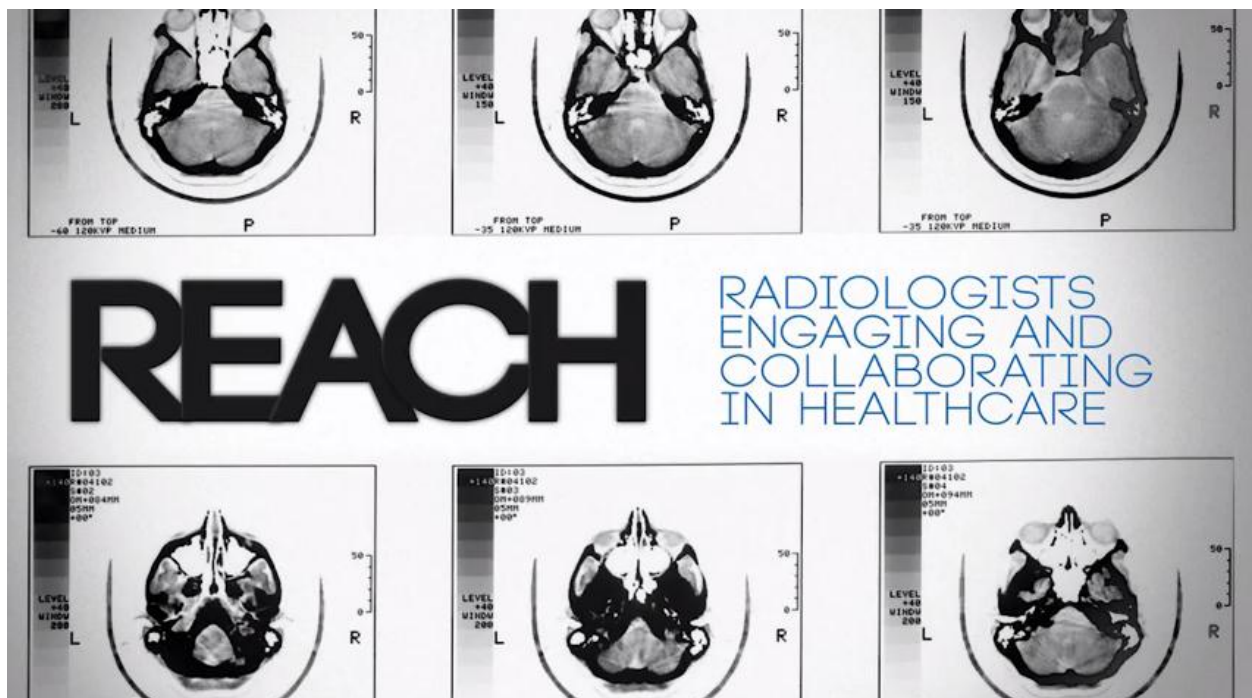
Clinical Decision Support (CDS)/ACRselect: Interdisciplinary guideline-based EHR ordering system indicating the appropriateness of different tests tailored for to each specific indication. Protocolling studies just became more efficient! Thanks MGH!



Soon to be compatible with multiple popular EHR platforms (EPIC, Cerner, etc.).

Physician Decision Support: Move to standardized reporting templates with dropdown boxes for incidentalomas (Fleischner criteria, adrenal and renal mass recommendations, etc.).

REACH: Live interactive radiology consultation iPad application developed at John's Hopkins allowing consulting physicians to review studies live with a radiologist from the convenience of the inpatient floor or clinic, bringing radiology back to the bedside!
