### Medical Education Research Certificate (MERC) Workshop

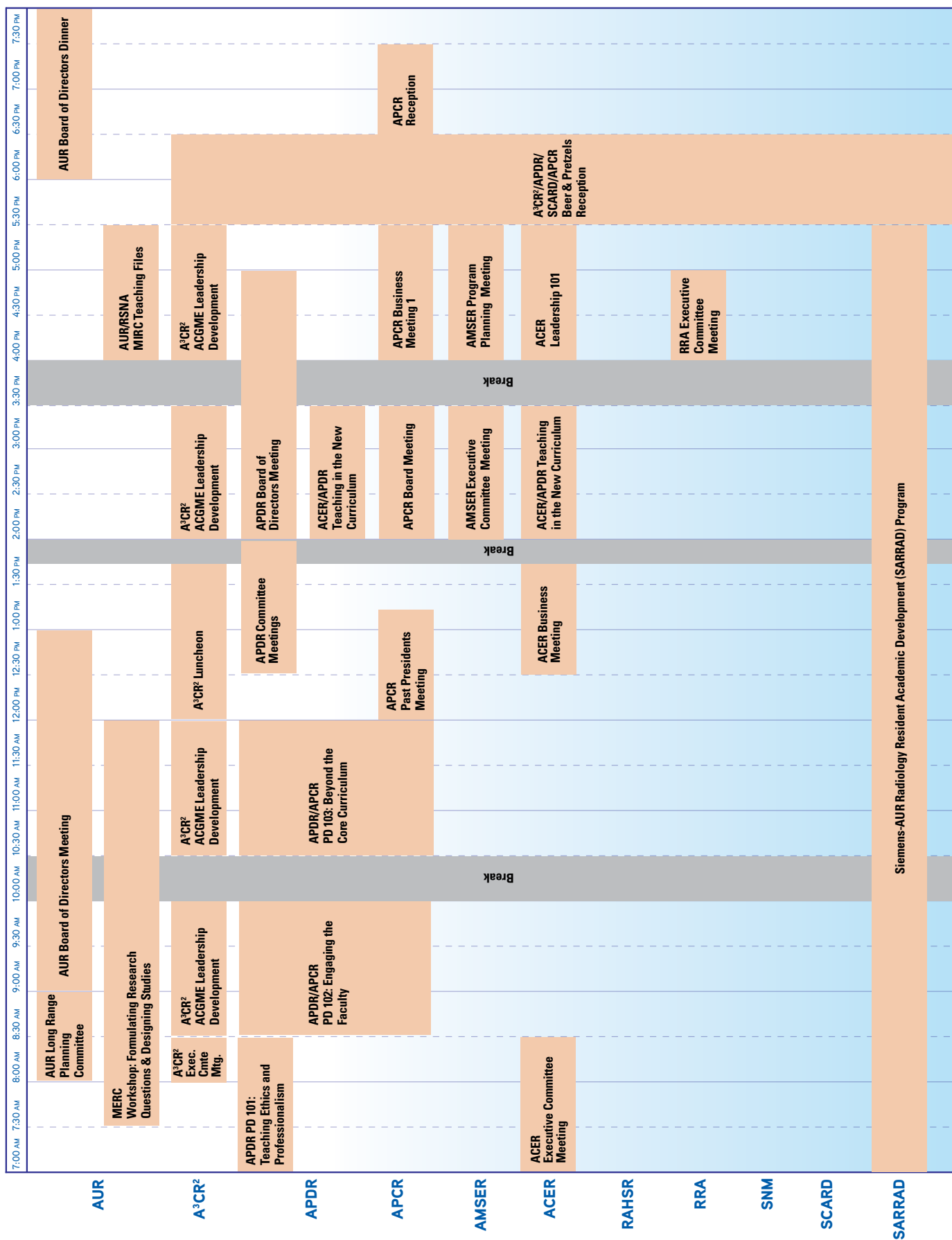

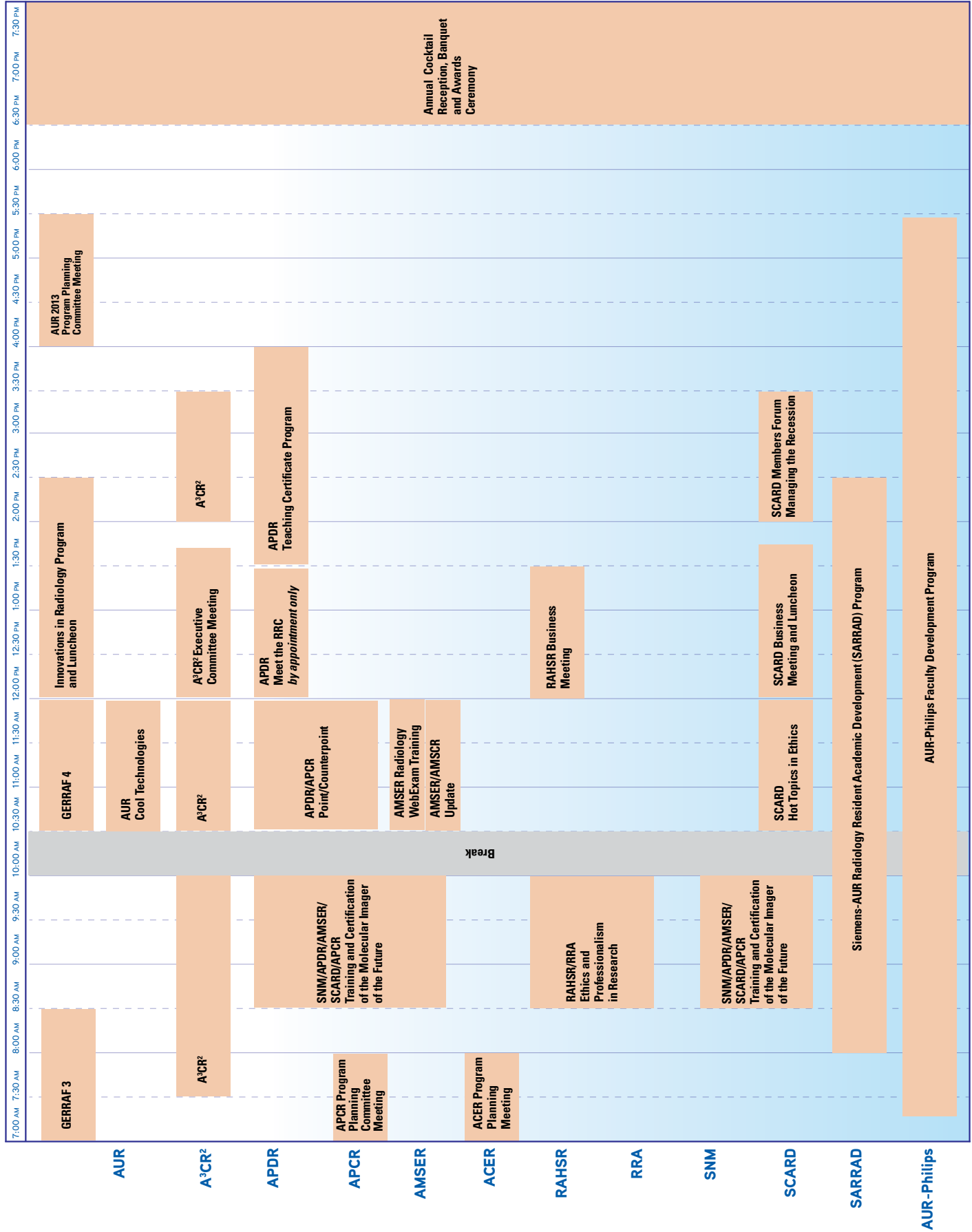

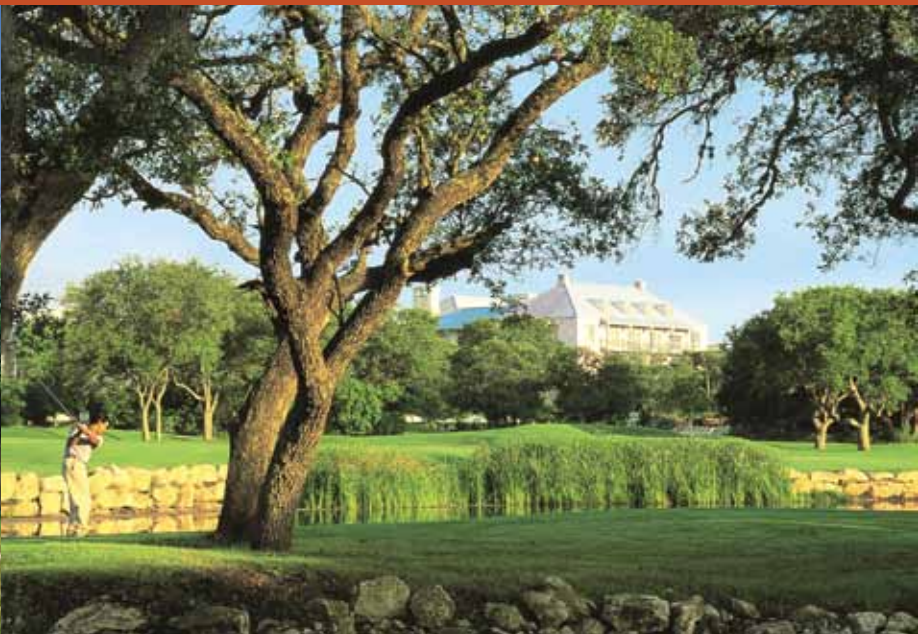
