CV Layout

- Clear & important categories in this CV
- Good Chronological flow: earliest to latest
 - Is 3 years too early for Associate?
- Honors well done— place to brag; essential to demonstrate your good work
- Clearly identify mentees (asterisk resident or fellow as author on paper)



CV Layout – add subtitles

- Presentations need to be **Numbered** and **Titled** to show where given
 - Department
 - Medical School
 - Hospital – other department
 - University
 - State Radiological Society
 - National Organizations
- Shows **recognition of you as an expert!**



Areas to strengthen

- Professional organizations
 - List alphabetically then **by yr.**
 - Membership demonstrates your focus
 - eg ***subspecialty*** society
 - List **committees** and **leadership** roles demonstrates your recognition as an **expert**



Areas to strengthen

- **Show where the expertise is focused?**
 - More publications in one area show expertise
 - More presentations
 - Presentations at national meetings
- **Increase Fetal Imaging** - most common theme
 - *5/17 publications; 2/21 presentations*
 - *3/13 book chapters; 4/15 exhibits 1/4 grants;*
 - Clinician educator/Radiation dose minor themes

CV Layout – areas to emphasize

- **Replace C. Professional background**
 - C. Academic Appointments
 - D. Clinical Hospital Administrative Positions –
Chief ER Radiology Service
 - E. Department of Radiology USCSOM:
Diagnostic Radiology Clerkship
all Committees, esp Chair – at least one major
 - F. Medical School:
Admissions Committee -major committee(chair?)



CV Layout

- **Specific Teaching Responsibilities-** how many students, how often, how many times a yr.
 - Daily teaching list is vague – can delete
 - ER service: be specific; how does ER, MR breast service & interventional coverage work?



CV – Emphasize leadership roles Medical Organizations - all societies

- **National – Alphabetical then dates and leadership roles.**
- American Board of Radiology
 - 2007-10 Written Board Exam writer
- American Society of Emergency Radiology
 - 2011 – present Exec committee, Secretary
- Association of University Radiologists
- Alliance Medical Student Educators in Radiology
 - 2010 – present Exec Committee, Secretary
- ARRS
- RSNA
- **Regional**
 - Los Angeles Radiological Society



Categories to emphasize strengths

- **Honors and Awards**

- 2008 – AJR Distinguished Reviewers
- 2010- Editorial Board, Emergency Radiology
- 2011 – USC Faculty Teaching Award (4th yr)

- **Presentations** - separate

- Local – Medical student lectures

- Grand Rounds USC

- Invited – all others – regional and national

- listing by title, dates, city/state/country

- Scientific Exhibits - stronger than posters**



Presentations – all

- **Chronological**
- **List accepted and change asap – every 6 mo.**
- **Submitted ok but doesn't count unless accepted**
- **Don't list "in preparation"**
- **Published Abstracts – list all in one place**
- **Media appearances don't count academically**



Areas to strengthen

- **Clarify your focus –
Emergency Radiology or Breast Imaging?**
- **Has it been a transition from one focus to a new expertise?**
- **Expertise needs to be proven with publications, presentations & leadership**
- **3 years as Associate Professor may be considered early & require national leadership**
